Our nutritionists assess the needs of each family. Together with the agronomists and animal scientists, they design a specialized nutritional program meeting the family's specific nutritional requirements and living situation.

Sustainable Farming

FTW's proven bio-intensive multi-crop model reduces the amount of land and water needed over conventional methods. It can be modified to thrive in any environment and is customized to meet the nutritional needs for the family and their small animals.

Our small animal component not only provides much needed protein and calcium, but also supplemental income for the family.

Education

The Educational component works hand in hand with agriculture to ensure a lasting change. Instruction on self-sufficient farming technologies is joined with low-cost simple techniques to improve the health, nutrition, and development of families for years to come.

FTW also trains applicants from NGOs and governments as extension agents to help move the program forward to help eradicate malnutrition.

Dignity & Hope

Dignity is restored to families as they work together on their own land as a self-sufficient family unit.

Hope is nurtured as families understand that they have the capacity and knowledge to take care of themselves. They now have the confidence that allows them to work on their farms effectively. They are no longer victims of the things that have previously plagued them.
